Directions: From Narromine:

Take Tullamore Road for 4 km.

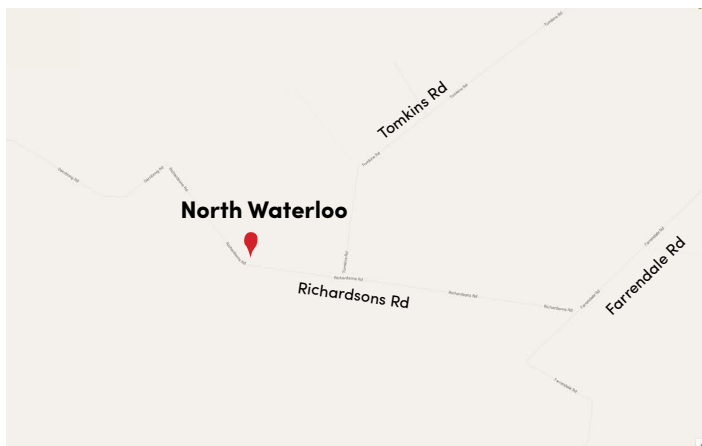
Turn right on Farrendale Road for 35 km.

Turn right on to Richardson’s Road for 7 km, over 3 grids.

Turn left into Nth Waterloo Machinery shed.

Follow road past shed, keeping shed on your right for 2 km towards Myall Tree Line. Continue following road to solar bore.
